FIND IT IN THE BIBLE: MATTHEW

This week's story comes from the book of Matthew. Matthew is the first of four books known as the Gospels.

The author of this book is likely the tax collector named Matthew, who became a follower of Jesus. The book of Matthew gives readers a perspective on the life of Jesus and confirms Him as the Messiah.

OT-NT CONNECTION

Throughout the Bible, God uses light to show how holy and righteous He is. **Read Exodus 34:29-35.**

- Why was Moses' face radiant when he came down from Mount Sinai?
- What did Moses cover his face with?
- When you pray, you are speaking to the same God Moses did! Pray and ask God to help you be a light to those around you!

HOW DO I REFLECT THE LIGHT OF JESUS?

God made every single person in His image, but we still struggle with sin. When we put our faith in Jesus, we are changed. We become a new creation. We are still made in God's image, but His Holy Spirit helps us become more like Him in the things we think, do and say. When we do what God would, we reflect His light like a mirror. When we live for Jesus, the world can see His light in our faith and actions.

HOW DO I BECOME A CHILD OF THE LIGHT?

The Bible tells us in Acts 16:31 and 1 Corinthians 15:3-4 that if we believe in Jesus (that He died, was buried and rose again) we will be saved. We become part of God's family and a child of the light. That's good news!

JOURNAL

Write down several ways your family can share the light of Jesus with your neighbors. Share your ideas with your family and look for ways to intentionally bless your neighbors through the New Year. In addition to acts of kindness, pray for them daily. Ask God to reach them with His light. Write about your experience in your journal.

READ



Read Ephesians 5:8-20. Paul tells us that because of Jesus we are children of light. His light shows us our sin and where we have become lazy in our relationship with Jesus. Take some time to pray and ask Jesus to help you prioritize your relationship with Him.

PLAY



Play a game of hide-and-seek with your family. Talk about how the light of Jesus can reach us no matter where we are — even when we're hiding! Remind them how we can share His light wherever we go.

FIND



This week's verse is found in the book of Matthew. Help your child find the book of Matthew. Is this book in the Old or New Testament? How many chapters are there?

SHARE

Talk about your faith story. Explain how the light of Jesus showed you the darkness of your sin, how your life was changed when you trusted Jesus and how the Holy Spirit works inside of you today.

Emphasize that a growing faith takes time, prayer and continued submission to the Lord.

LEARN



Create a maze by reflecting the light of a flashlight off of several small, angled mirrors. See how long the light will reflect and how creative you can get by directing its beam around obstacles. Remind your kids that the light of Jesus (the flashlight) is reflected off of us (the mirrors) to one another.


